An interdisciplinary program combining chemistry, physics, biomaterials, math and engineering to examine topics including:

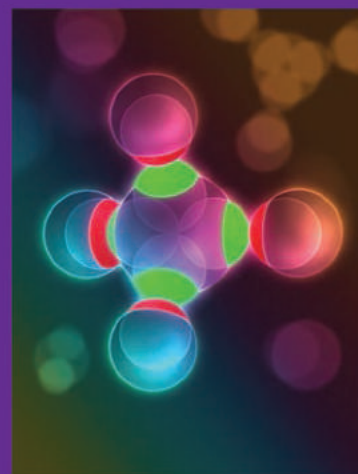
- Computational materials chemistry

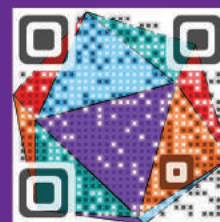
