Dear Colleagues:

I write with a brief introduction to the **2020 Duke summer undergraduate research program in theoretical chemistry**. The program, now in its second year, is aimed at rising seniors with a strong interest in theoretical chemistry research, especially those who are considering graduate studies in theoretical chemistry. Nine faculty from across our campus - with wide-ranging activities in theory - will run this eight-week program, which will include a mentored research project, weekly seminars/discussions led by students and faculty, and some group outings. The program will provide a stipend, on-campus housing, and a travel allowance.
