Join us for the final session of Pitt Ed Tech Days, where we'll introduce beginners to educational technologies. This session will be held in person in B-26 Alumni Hall.



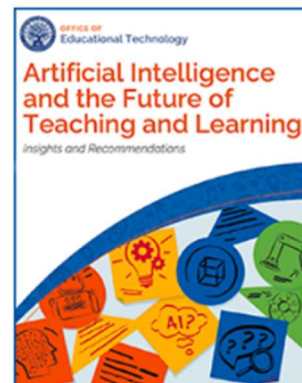
